1. Our AGM: FOR MEMBERS OF GCS ONLY



Important Social development news:

The Sussex Police Department have launched a new social initiative to integrate and establish ongoing contact with all Faith Communities in Sussex. Acting *Inspector A/I Neil is leading this who has been communicating with our Inter* Faith Representative Dr. Milind Jani, who arranged a preliminary meeting at the Temple in order to familiarize him with our Hindu Faith and the needs of our Community. They have offered an application for funding - an amount of £500 as a one off- for an elderly group event.

Here is a brief from A/I Neil Bates:

"I am an Acting Inspector with Sussex Police and have recently taken up our faith Champion role for the Buddhist, Hindu and Sikh faiths. As an organisation, Sussex Police is committed to making itself accessible to every community and our two key priorities are:

- 1) To provide support to faith and belief communities in accessing policing
- 2) To improve trust and confidence within faith communities to increase reporting of hate crime and other crime.

I have recently been in touch with members of the Gujarati Cultural Society to introduce myself and to develop my own understanding of Hinduism and its rich culture. I am seeking to better understand what issues your community is facing and how we can work together to address them. I have been overwhelmed by the warm welcome I have received and was delighted to have the chance to visit the Temple in Brighton recently.

I am looking forward to developing this relationship in the near future and hopefully meeting more of the community.
